Carl Olsen seeks clarification on the court's order of February 20, 2025, recusing the judge in this case. Iowa Rules of Civil Procedure 1.904(3) requires this motion to be filed within 15 days after the ruling. Mr. Olsen seeks leave to file this motion approximately one month after that 15-day deadline.

A copy of the court's February 20, 2025, order is attached to this motion.

Last week, Mr. Olsen called the clerk of court asking if it was unusual that another judge has not been assigned. The clerk said it was unusual, and she would ask the court administrator to assign a new judge. As of today, a new judge has not been assigned.

Mr. Olsen seeks clarification on what caused the judge to issue an order of recusal, if that has any bearing on this case, and what steps Mr. Olsen should take to avoid delay.
