On this date, counsel for the parties appeared for a final status conference regarding a non-jury trial scheduled for August 10, 2026.

The parties expect this trial to last two days.

The Plaintiff has filed five motions for judicial notice (D0056, D0057, D0058, D0059, D0060). These motions will be addressed at the time of trial.

If either party wishes to present a witness either via perpetuation or by Zoom, they need to inform the court prior to the scheduled testimony. Transcripts of any perpetuated witness must be provided to the court prior to the start of trial and the parties shall indicate if there are objections to be ruled upon. If any witness needs to be called out of order, the offering party must notify the court as soon as practical.

All exhibits to be admitted shall be kept in electronic form, if possible. Polk County courtrooms are equipped with audio/video equipment and the parties shall not bring in their own video projectors or televisions. Counsel needs to have a laptop with an HDMI connection to hook into the courtroom A/V system.

The parties will be notified of the courtroom assignment on the Friday afternoon prior to trial.
